### AGERATUM Artist Purple

## NURSERY



### AESCULUS carnea Briotii

☀️🌿 18-35' h 18-35' w 4' p SPRING

(Ruby Red Horse Chestnut) Round growth habit. Spectacular red flowers. Dark green leaves turn yellow in the fall.



### BUXUS x. Green Velvet

☀️🌿 3' h 3' w 1.5' p

(Green Velvet Boxwood) Globe growth habit. Round full-bodied boxwood well suited for low hedges. Vigorous habit and good green color throughout winter.



### CHAMAECYPARIS pisifera Mops

☀️🌿 3' h 3' w 2' p

(Mops Cypress) Brilliant gold threadlike foliage that retains its color in heat and humidity; low mounding habit



### CLETHRA alnifolia Hummingbird

☀️🌿 30" h 30" w 18" p SUMMER

(Hummingbird Summersweet) Deliciously fragrant upright panicles of white flowers in mid-summer are highlighted against a background of glossy dark green foliage. Dense mounded habit, good yellow fall color.



### COTONEASTER x. Hessei

☀️🌿 2' h 5' w 18" p SPRING

(Hessei Cotoneaster) Deciduous horizontally-branched mounding shrub. Lustrous green leaves turn to rich burgundy in fall. Pinkish red flowers and large red berries. Very hardy. Excellent as a border or groundcover.



### FAGUS sylvatica Roseo-marginata

☀️ 30' h 20' w 4-5" bb

(Tricolor Beech) Striking green leaves marked with white and edged pink. Leaf color most intense in spring.



### HYDRANGEA paniculata Pink Diamond

☀️🌿 6-9' h 3-6' w 4' p SUMMER

(Pink Diamond Hydrangea) Rounded growth habit. Large, solid panicles bloom freely in July and August. Flowers open a creamy-white and transform into a deep pink-burgundy color



### ROSA Knockout

☀️ 3' h 3' w 15" p SUMMER

(Knockout Shrub Rose) Fuchsia, single flowers. A Free flowering, disease tolerant, hybrid shrub rose. Requires minimum maintenance.

## PERENNIALS



### CAMPANULA punctata Cherry Bells

☀️🌿 18-28" h SUMMER

(Spotted Bellflower) Big, bright cherry pink bells with reddish-purple spots inside are borne on erect stems. Excellent cut flower. Tends to spread more quickly than other punctatas. Forms compact rosettes of soft green, ovate, toothed leaves.



### COREOPSIS v. Moonbeam

☀️ 18" h SUMMER

(Tickseed) Creamy yellow flowers atop soft needle-like clumps of foliage all summer. Well drained medium rich soil.



### ECHINACEA p. Magnus

☀️ 36" h SUMMER

(Coneflower) Huge flat flower heads of rose-pink. Attractive seed heads in fall and winter. well drained fertile soil.



### GERANIUM Brookside

☀️ 12-18" h SUMMER

(Cranesbill) Best blue, large cup-shaped flowers, blooms longer than Johnson's Blue, fast growing. Well drained soil.



### NEPETA Walker's Low

☀️🌿 18-24" h SUMMER

(Catmint) Gray-green foliage. Soft lavender-blue flowers. Lovely with yellow or gold achilleas. Ordinary well drained soil.



### RUDEBECKIA f. Goldstrum

☀️🌿 24-30" h SUMMER

(Black-Eyed Susan) Golden yellow flowers. Mildew resistant. Black coned seed heads provide winter interest, long bloom time, excellent cut flower. Long lived, easy to grow. Average soil.



### SALVIA n. Caradonna

☀️ 24-30" h SUMMER

(Meadow Sage, Perennial Salvia) From Germany comes this very attractive salvia with glowing purple stems. Long flowering. Moist well drained soil.
